Outreach programme on Explore Microbial World to Young Minds

29/09/2023

We from the Department of Microbiology, Thassim Beevi Abdul Kader College for Women, Kilakarai, students and faculty members, planned to celebrate the **Microorganisms day, September 17**, in which we organise out-reach program for school students in the region of kilakarai.

Since Ist terminal exams ongoing this month, our invitation was accepted by only two schools in Kilakarai. They are **Pearls Matriculation Hr. Sec. School** and **Islamiah High school**. 11 students of our department (I, II and III BSc Microbiology) and two faculty members Dr G Hemapoojavalli and Ms K Ganishka were engaged to bring the students to both schools.

On **26/7/2023** students went to **Pearl Matriculation higher secondary school**. We left the college campus reached the school around 1.00pm, program begins at 1:30 and ended at 2:30pm; 6th 7th and 8th standard students of the accountability of 70 are benefitted in the program.

On **27/7/2023** students went to **Islamiah High school** and students of 4th 5th were involved in the activity. In this school around 80 students were benefitted by the program. We left the college campus reached the school around 11.45pm; program begins at 12:00 and ended at 1.00pm.

Kids don't aware of microorganisms. Our students prepared posters, which represent the microorganism's involvement in our day to day life activities and harmfulness; they taught the students in order to inculcate the awareness on microorganisms and increase their knowledge of microbial benefits and harmfulness. Microorganisms present in everywhere; we eat dosas, idlis,

pizzas, baking items, chocolates, ice-creams, sweets etc., confirm the need of microbes; we live literally in the world of microbes; which will be very attractive to the students.

Also it is necessary for them to know about the effects of microorganisms and to maintain the personal hygiene. They emphasized about the microorganism presence in the nails, hair and skin, so we have to take foods after washing their hands completely by using antiseptic soaps so they can prevent them from various deadly diseases. Foods present in the air will contaminate the foods we eat, so we have to eat speedily or will be affected by food borne infections and food poisonings. They also taught how to use microscope; they viewed some permanent slides of microorganisms (*Penicillium* sp. *Aspergillus niger* and coocus). Those were so happily welcoming and enthusiastically interacted with our presenters and had lots of queries. Students had so much fun and enjoyed seeing the little microbes.

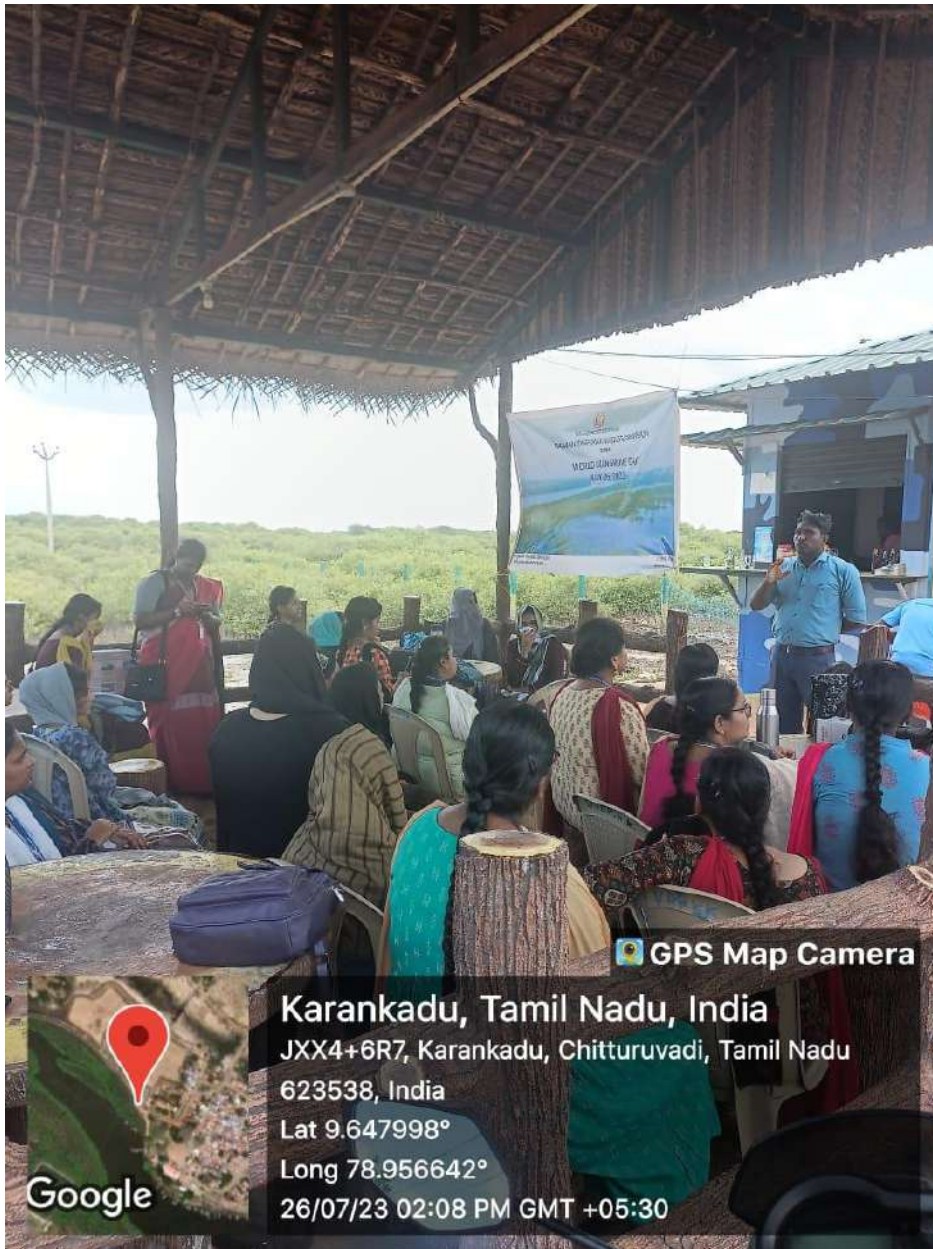

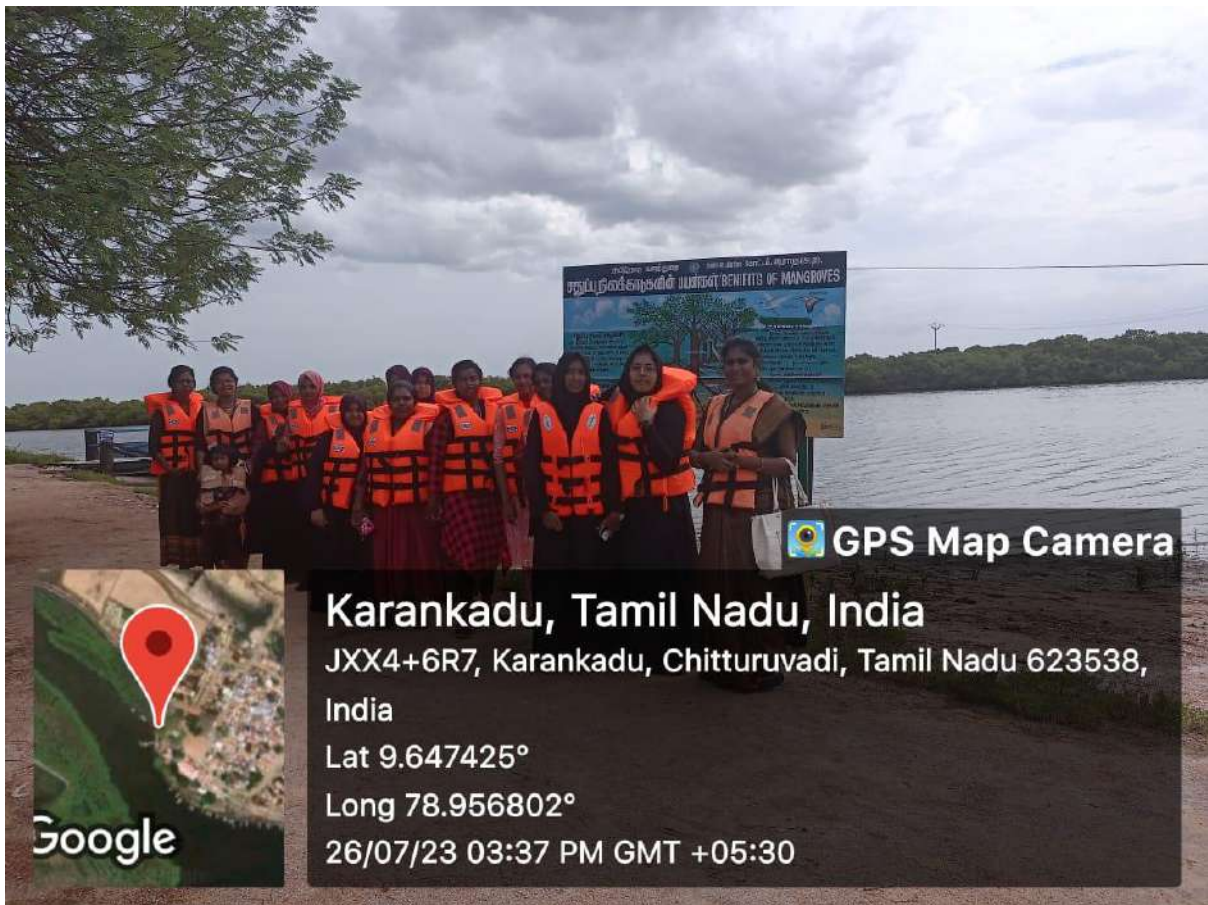

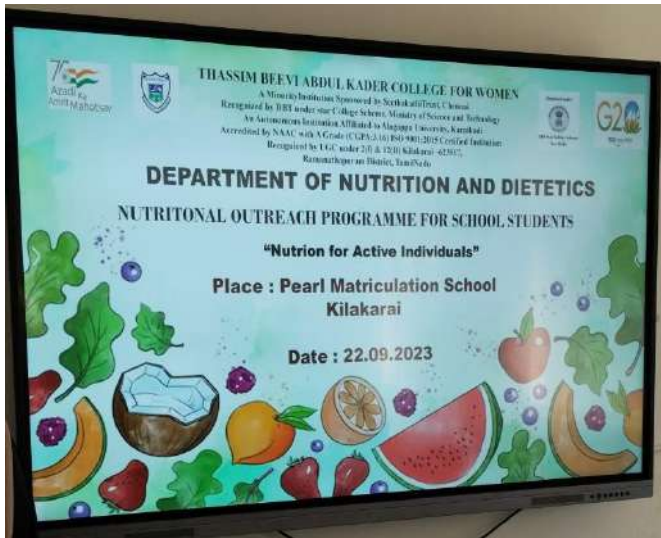
NATIONAL NUTRITION MONTH CELEBRATION

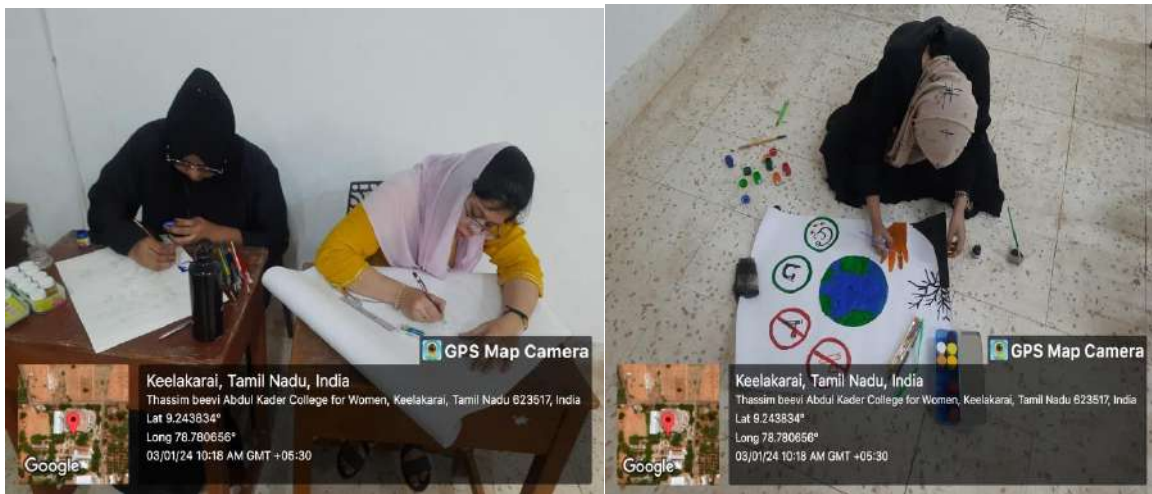
