EVENT REPORT

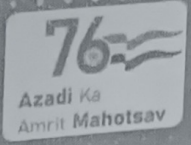

The main objective of the program is to obtain the necessary knowledge to solve Analytical Geometry problems through Geogebra capacities.

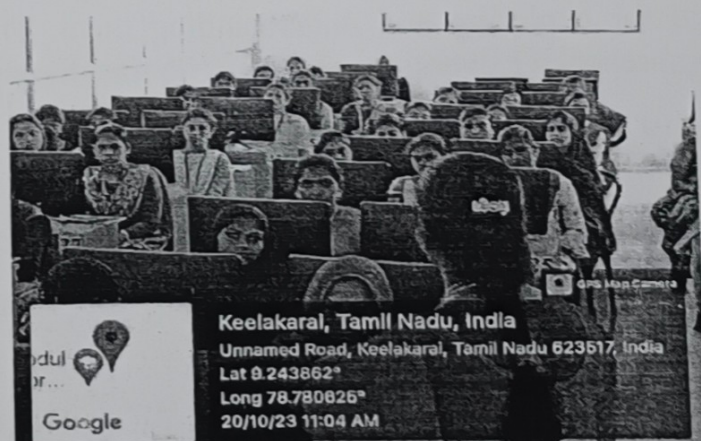

Introduction to Scilab:-

SCILAB is a free and open source, cross platform computational package and high level oriented programming language. It can be used for signal processing, statistical analysis, fluid dynamics, simulations, numerical optimization and modeling, simulation of explicit and implicit dynamical systems and (if the corresponding toolbox is installed) symbolic manipulations. Scilab is one of the two major open-source alternatives to MATLAB, the other one being GNU Octave. Scilab puts less emphasis on syntactic compatibility with MATLAB. This allows users to rapidly construct models for a range of mathematical problems. While the language provides simple matrix operations such as multiplication, the Scilab package also provides a library of high-level operations such as correlation and complex multidimensional arithmetic operations.

BRIDGE INTENSIVE COURSE 2023 -2024

EVENT REPORT

Date: 10.07.2023

The Department of English conducts Bridge Intensive Course training for the newly joined first year students every year before the commencement of their regular classes in order to facilitate and bridge the gap between the school and college level of learning. The Bridge Intensive Course in English aims at new students' transformation from school to collegiate study in using English effectively for their academic study and hence it focuses on improving the four skills (LSRW) – Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing Skills of the beginners.

Course Objectives:

The primacy of the course is :

- To pave a platform to the new students to adapt to the new academic environment as a confidence boosting Course in communicating English effectively.
- To enhance the basic communication skills - LSRW and the verbal components.
- To infer information presented in different learning sources.
- To learn the ability to respond aptly and communicate their ideas in a coherent manner.

Course Outcome:

At the end of the course, the learners will be able to:

- ❖ Assess one's own level of language skills & proficiency and know their strength.
- ❖ Become a more confident individual in using English effectively in day-to-day life.
- ❖ Identify the basic grammatical structures.
- ❖ Develop effective communication

It is a 5-day training course of three sessions per each day which usually starts from diagnostic test, then intensifies Course and ends with Exit test - the Achievement test. Then, analyzing the students' language acquisition & proficiency level based on the score of the students' performance in the Exit test, they are segregated into separate batches for Part II Language - Level I & II , for further communication skill enhancement.

The Bridge Intensive Course for Academic Year 2023-2024 was conducted as a 5-day training course of three sessions per a day from 023rd to 27th June 2023 and 3rd & 4th July 2023 according to the level of the students. Prior to the commencement of the training, the Diagnostic test was conducted on 19.6.2023 at entry level for 25 marks to testify their cognitive competence level in English language learning and understanding according to the basic verbal skills which the students learnt in Schools. Nearly around 480 students of various disciplines attended the diagnostic test.

The following day, based on the range of marks the students scored, they were segregated into 8 batches and accordingly their acquisition level of English language proficiency, they were categorized as Intermediate, and the Advanced. The Level I- Intermediate Syllabus was offered to the intermediate and the beginner level students and on the other hand Level II - Advanced Syllabus was offered to the Advanced learners in English. Each batch has its Course trainers and a student tutor. On the whole, 13 faculty trainers and 13 student tutors were involved in the training classes, commenced with syllabus orientation and Ice- breaking - Warmer Activities. The Course was designed to enhance all the LSRW Skills along with grammar and vocabulary components as an Activity-oriented training with five participatory activity modules. At the end of the Bridge Intensive Course, the Exit test was conducted on 4th July 2023 and nearly 490 students attended including the newly admitted students of all departments.

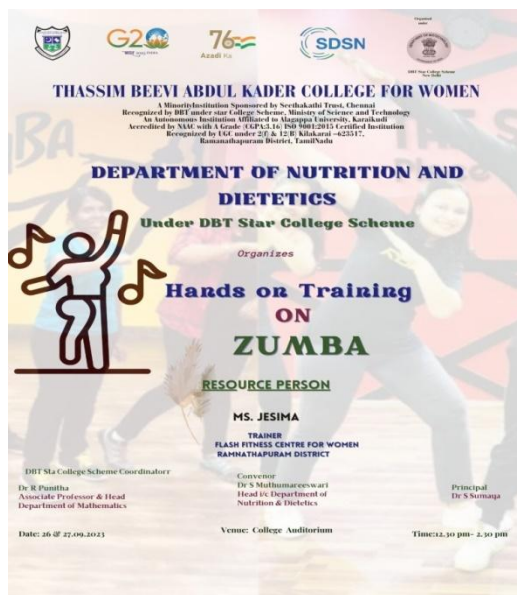

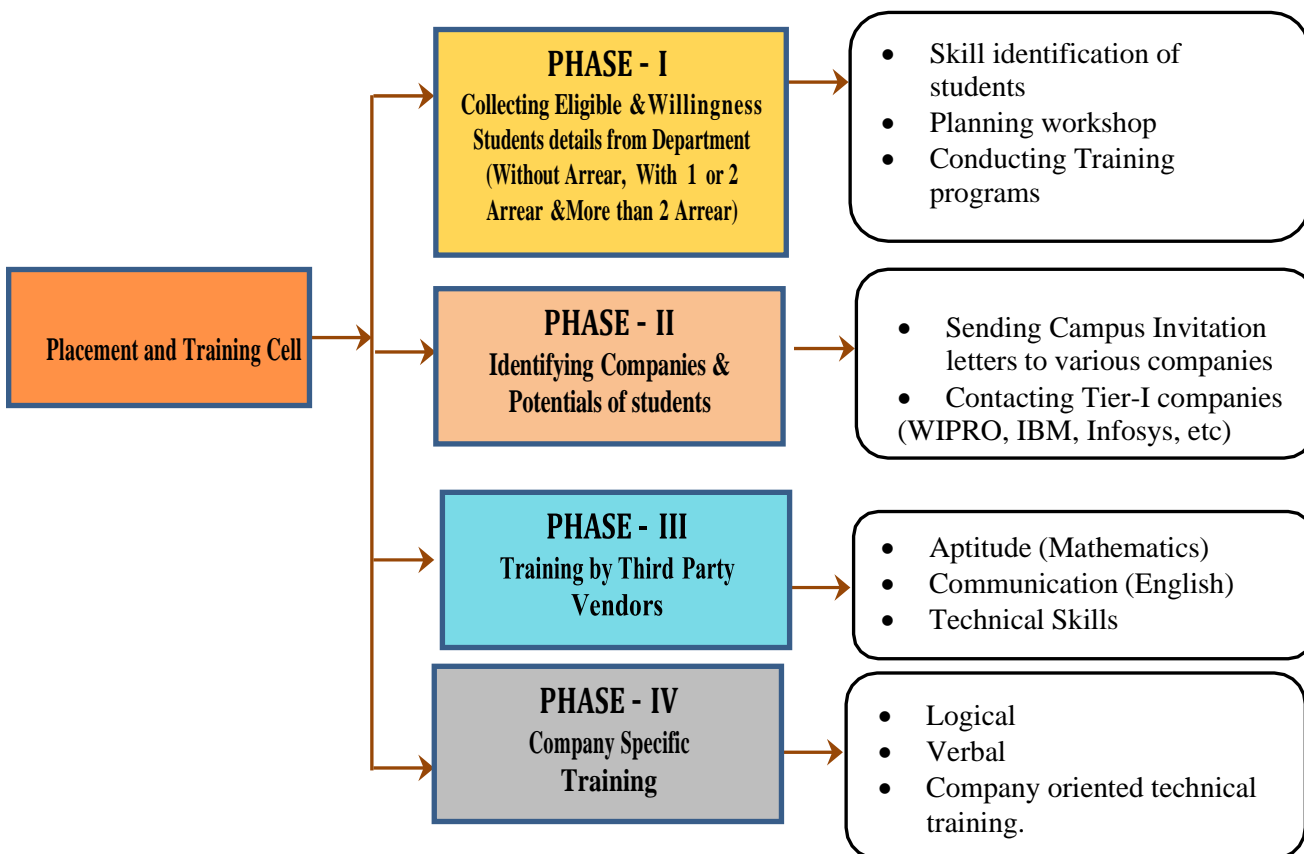
Annual Report for the Academic Year – 2023-2024

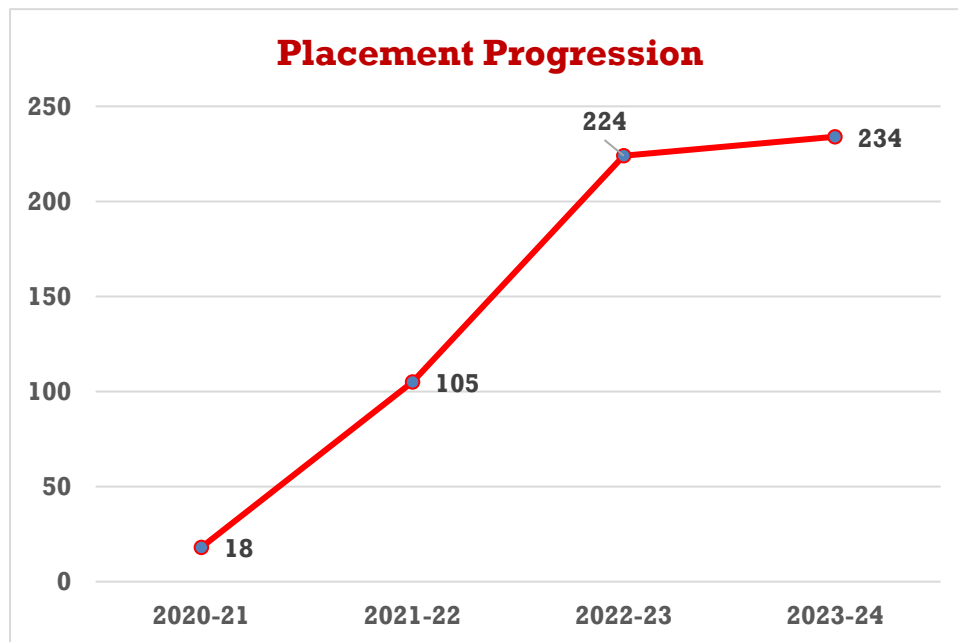
